


## Checking the Order Status

To check the status of your order, select Trades and click on to Today's Orders.

Check the 'Status' column for the status of the order, you may refer to the legend for the description.

You are required to check under "Qty" & "Qty Done" column to ensure that you have executed the correct quantity.
